STEP ONE

READ INSTRUCTIONS IN FULL

Prisons have strict rules we MUST follow or we will get the cards back.

Follow The Important Information Below.

STEP TWO

WRITE A MESSAGE OF LOVE, HOPE + JOY

Our goal is to speak life into the person receiving your card. Remind them that they are loved and that they matter.

The back side has examples you can write.

STEP THREE

STOP! JUST HOLD ONTO THEM

No, seriously.

If you are done writing your cards - just stop, sit back and relax and then proceed to the next step.

STEP FOUR

DROP THEM LIKE IT'S HOT ON DECEMBER 16TH
